**Miniature Quilt:** Uses blocks no larger than 5" and measures no more than 24" on any one side. A quilt larger than this is categorized as a wall hanging. Information reprinted from *Miniature Quilts Magazine*.

**Wall Hanging:** Any quilt suitable for display on a wall excluding miniature quilts.

**Lap Quilt:** A quilt meant to curl up in and is generally smaller than a bed size quilt.

**Baby Quilt** is meant to fit a crib and is generally about 38" x 50".

**Bed Size Quilt:** A quilt meant to be used on a bed.

**Heirloom:** A quilt that has been passed down through the generations.

**Wearable Art:** An item of clothing, quilted or pieced in some way.

**Serendipity Quilt:** A quilted item that doesn't fit another category. For example: tree skirts, chatelaine, etc.

**Innovative Quilt:** Any materials, techniques or combination of techniques used in a nontraditional way. This could also be a pattern designed by the quiltmaker or a significant change in a design.

**Applique:** A piece of fabric that is secured (or "applied") onto a background fabric with hand or machine stitches.

**Table Runner/Topper:** A quilted item that is meant to be displayed on a table. This would include runners, tablecloths, placemats, etc.

**Youth Quilt:** A quilt made by someone 18 years of age and younger.

**Group Quilt:** Any quilt pieced by 2 or more people.

**First Quilt:** First quilt entered in a show. If you have 5 quilts and you have never entered a quilt in a show, you must pick one of the 5 to be entered in this category. The remainder of the quilts will be entered in another category on the form.

**Quilt Kit:** A kit purchased from a store where all the material is chosen and provided for you by somebody other than you.

Please keep bottom half for your records

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Entry must have label on back lower right corner with maker's name, address, and phone number.

Bring your quilts to the Saxman Community Center between 5:00 and 7:00, Wednesday, February 17.
